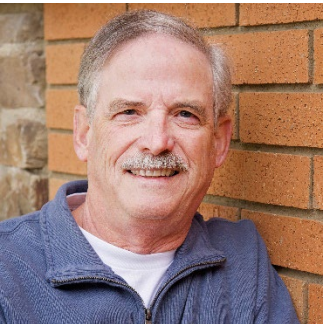

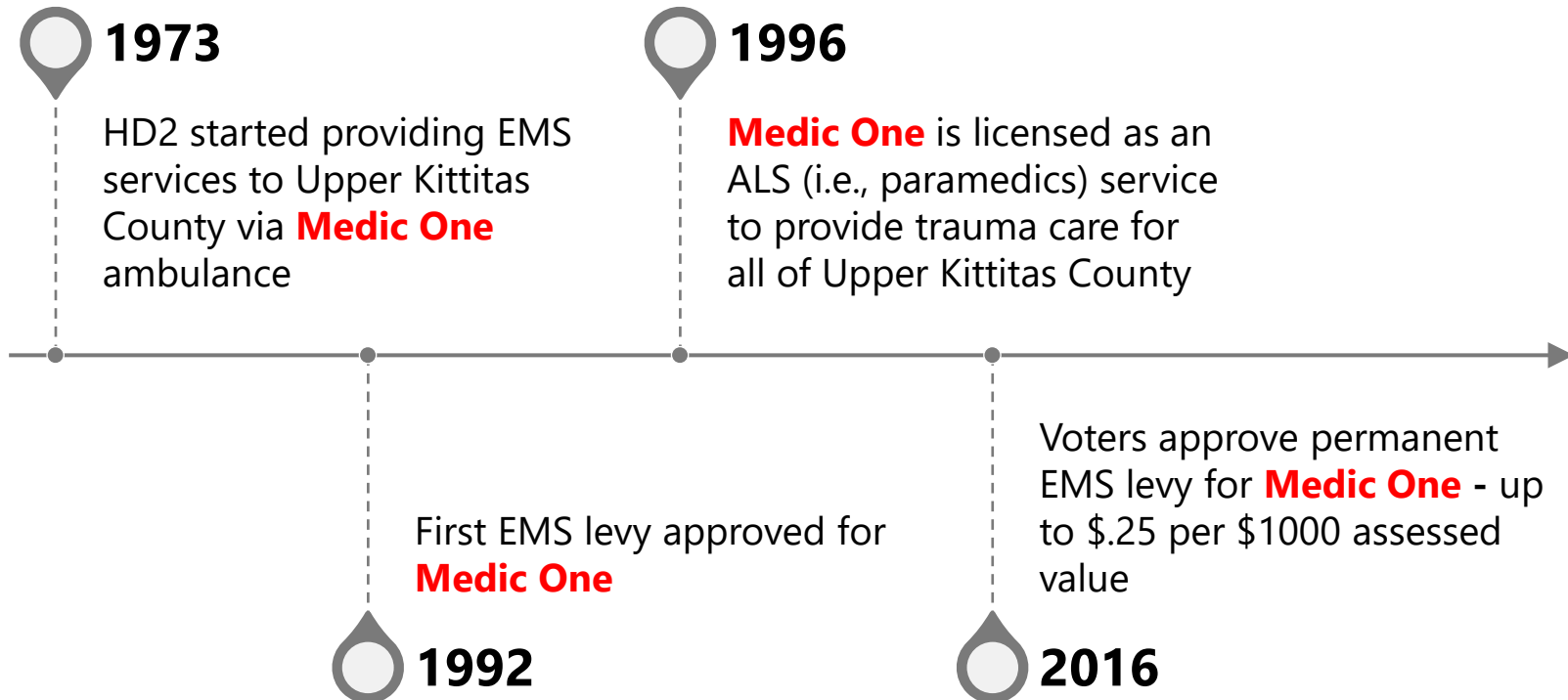

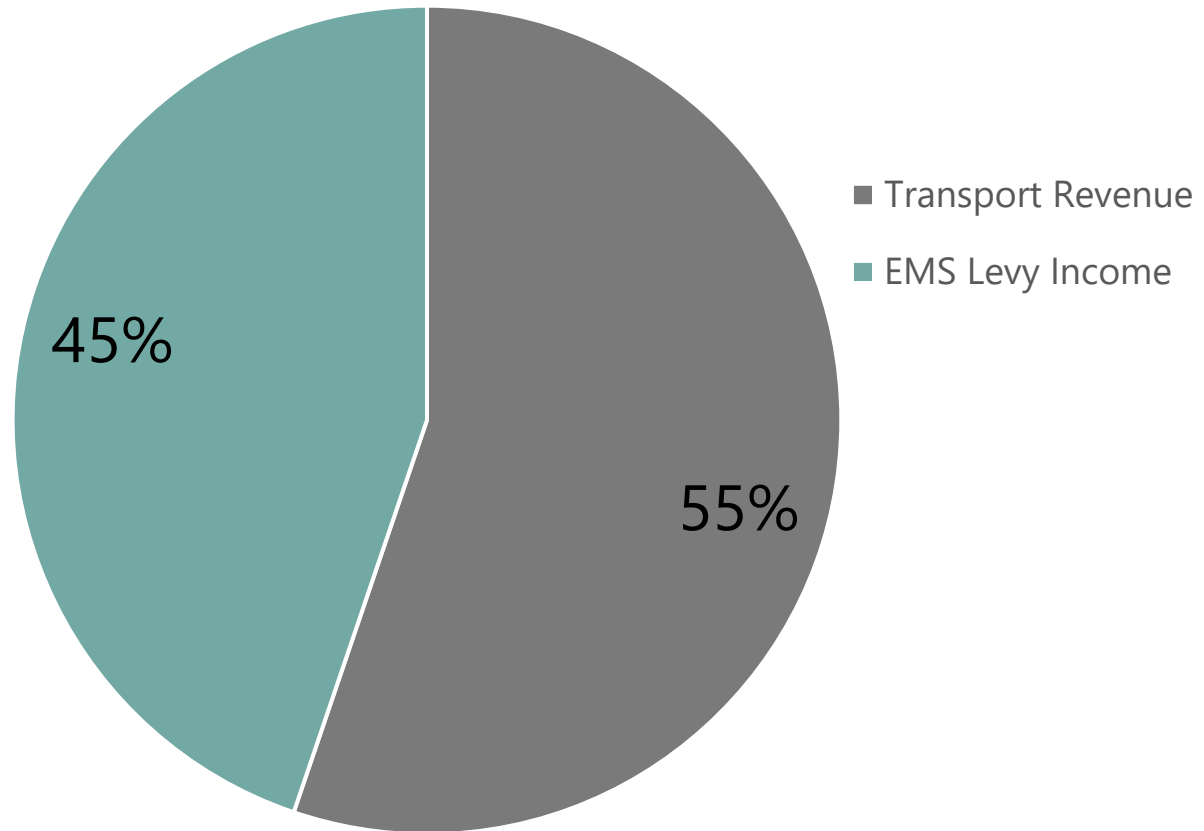
KCPHD NO. 2 (FORMED IN 1969)





MEDIC ONE AMBULANCE REVENUE

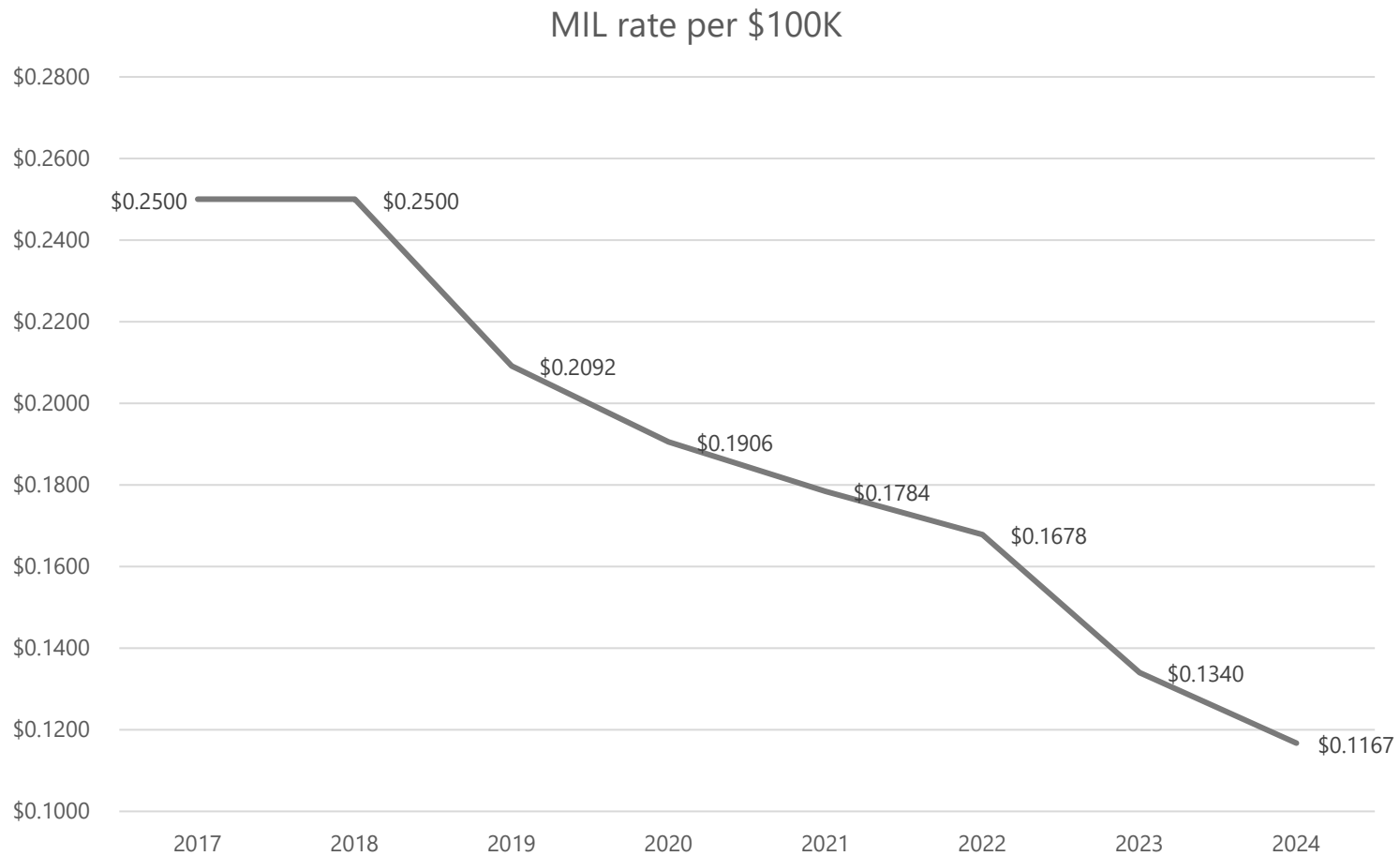

MEDIC ONE EMS LEVY

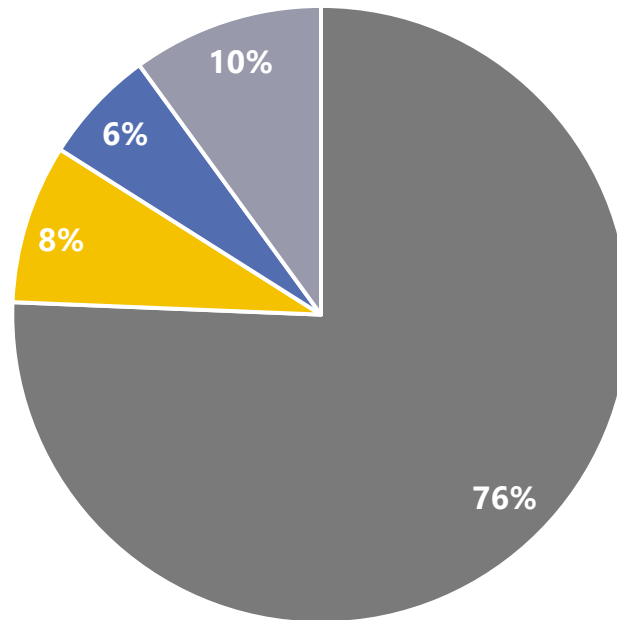

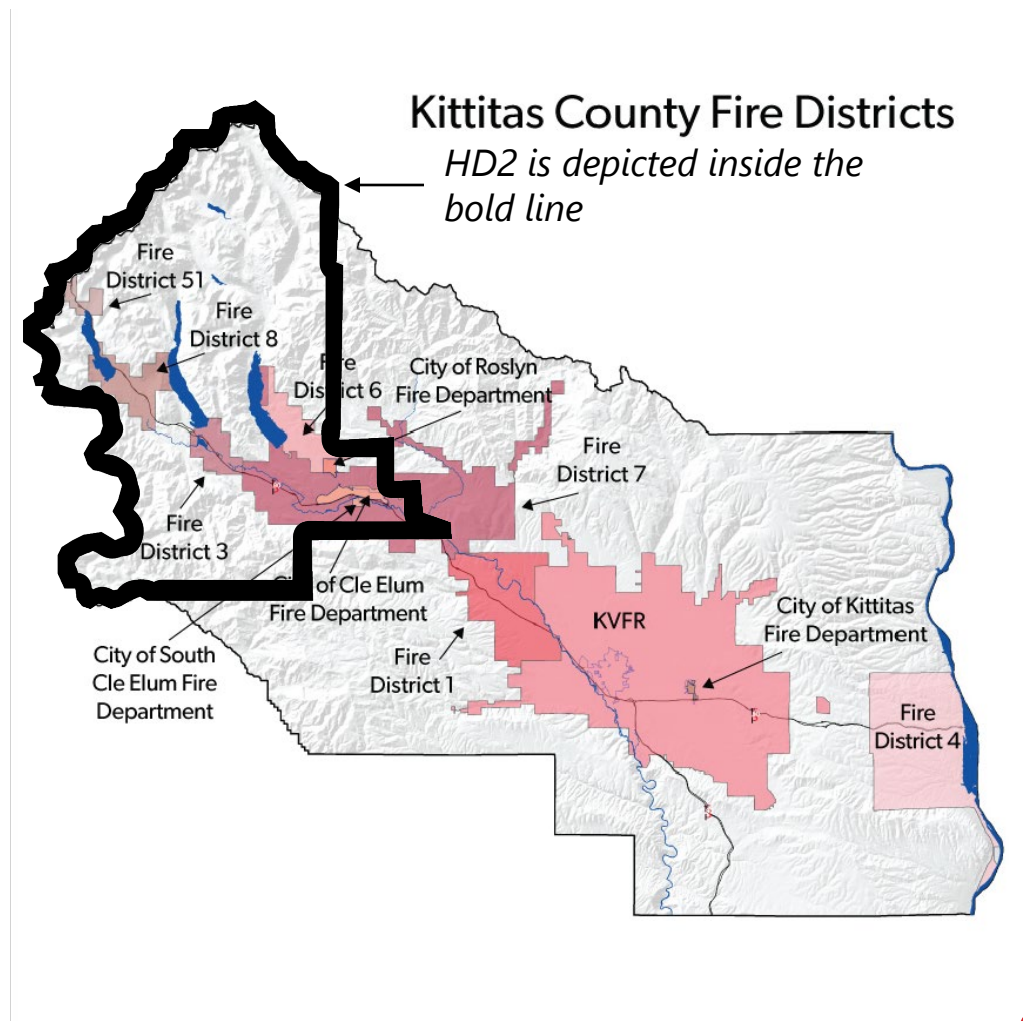
24/7/365 Advanced Life Support Paramedic Ambulance Service

UPPER KITTITAS COUNTY AMBULANCE RESPONSE MODEL



911 call in any area of Upper Kittitas County → dispatch Medic One's Advanced Life Support Ambulance with a paramedic and EMT.

Basic Life Support from the appropriate fire district is dispatched and may respond inside their fire district or city.

Medic One ALS and any responding BLS fire unit arrive and cares for patient.

The decision whether to transport the patient to a Hospital is made by Medic One paramedic and patient.

If the patient is transported to a Hospital, patient is billed for services.

If the patient is not transported to a Hospital, there is no billing to the patient.

*Staffed out of Station 99;

- **Unit 993**
Minimum 1 paramedic, 1 EMT
*Staffed out of FD7's Station 73;
Off Golf Course Road exit*
- **Unit 992 – 3rd Unit staffed on
high volume weekends**
Minimum 1 paramedic, 1 EMT
Staffed out of Station 99

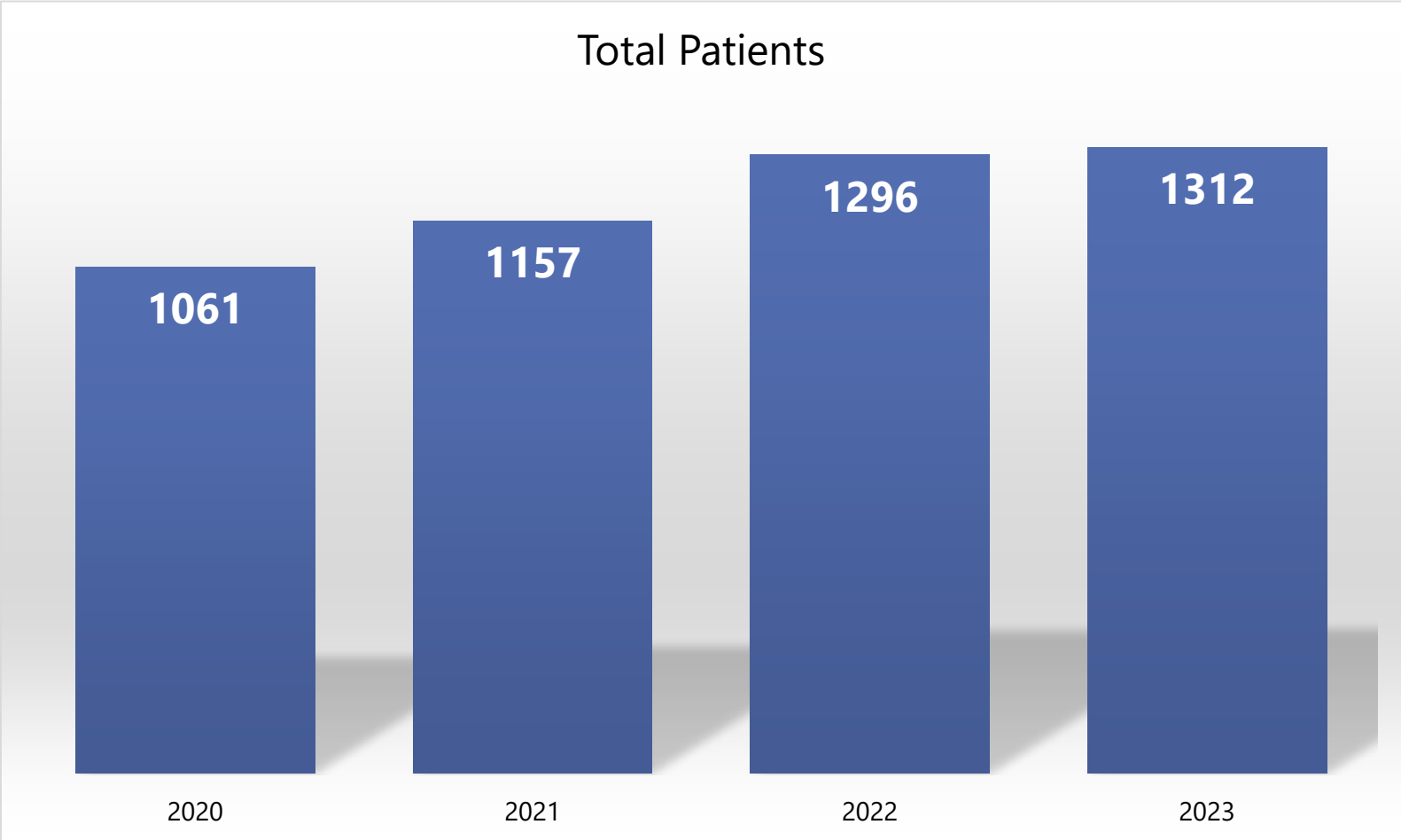
- **Medic One Advanced Life Support (i.e., paramedics)**
